



Rules of the School



1. Enrolment to the school on the part of the pupil and parents willingness to comply with the requirements and regulations of the school.
2. Parents are earnestly requested to see that their children attend the school punctually. They are expected to, co-operate with the work of the school by enforcing Regularity and Discipline and by taking a keen interest in the Children's Progress. They should check the diary regularly and note the teacher's remarks etc.
3. Pupils who have been absent from class must have the reason entered in the Diary stating the cause for the absence with the parent's signature.
4. All the children are expected to come to school daily, in freshly laundered Uniforms with Clean Socks and well polished shoes.
5. Absence for 6 or more continuous working days without sending leave letter will be taken to mean that the student has left the school.
6. No pupil shall leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal.
7. Parents or Guardians are not allowed to see their children during school hours without the permission of the Principal.
8. The Principal has the right to suspend or require the withdrawal of any student without having to state any reason, provided she/he is satisfied that such a step is necessary in the interest of the school or of the child.
9. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belonging by having them neatly labeled. They will not wear any Gold or silver ornaments in school.
10. Any act of Indiscipline may result in a child being expelled from the school.
11. Late comers will be sent back home.
12. No Half a day's leave is permitted.
13. Absenteeism during the monthly tests and terminal examinations will not be condoned. If a student is absent for monthly tests or terminal examinations, it will affect his/her promotion.
14. It is compulsory for the student to be present on the Re-Opening days, closing days of the school and important functions of the school.
15. Going from one class to another should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
16. Inside the campus the students Should Talk only in English.
17. Pupils are expected to keep the class rooms and the school Premises Absolutely clean.

18. Any pupil who tampers the school property or found and kind of lapse is liable for severe Disciplinary action and the damage will have to be borne by the student.
19. Students are strictly forbidden to bring objectionable books, newspapers, novels or any unwanted, materials to the school premises.
20. Pupils failing for two consecutive years in the same class will not be allowed to continue in the school.
21. Parents should not disturb the teachers while they are in their class. Those who desire to meet the teachers about the progress of their children, may meet them in the staff room, after the class hours, after obtaining permission from the Principal.
22. The practice of private tuition is generally not encouraged special efforts to improve slow learners are taken by the school out of school hours. However parents desirous of arranging private tuition for their children with the teachers of the school shall apply to the Principal and prior permission from the school.
23. a) Those who apply for Transfer Certificate should give prior intimation of 7 days. The school fee for the entire term should be paid before applying for T.C.
b) If the parent desires to take T.C. it has to be applied on or before 30th of April.
24. Children who use the school bus should remit bus fee before 6th of every month. On no account late payment of bus fees will be accepted. Without the prior knowledge of the school authorities, the students should not discontinue the use of bus service.
25. The Student should remember that :
- a) They are Indians
 - b) They ought to be proud of India
 - c) They should be worthy of it
 - d) They should respect their parents, teachers and all elders.
26. Cellphones are strictly banned in our school. If any Student has brought the cellphone to school campus and if they are caught by the Teachers, then he/she will be suspended immediately from the school and the cell phone will not be given back to the students. The foundation for this attitude is discipline. Discipline is a training of mind and the character. It enables man to follow the rules that he himself has made to regulate his conduct and behaviour for his own good and for his own good and for the good of the society. Obedience, co-operation, avoidance of selfishness and greed, respect for elders, sense of service, duty and responsibility are attributes of discipline.
